Today's Program: Jim Bakker, Executive Director of the **Pilgrim Monument and Provincetown Museum**, spoke with us today about the significance of the monument, and their recent 100th Anniversary Celebration. As Jim explained, the pilgrim monument memorializes the pilgrims who uprooted their lives and made their first landing in the New World in Provincetown in 1620. The Mayflower pilgrims spent five weeks in Provincetown before moving on to Plymouth. It was actually Provincetown Harbor where they signed the Mayflower Compact to put forth the first self-determining democratic constitution.

President Theodore Roosevelt laid the cornerstone to launch the construction of the Pilgrim Monument in 1907. Three years later, in 1910, President William H. Taft led the dedication ceremony of the completed monument. In 2010, the 100th year anniversary celebrations are dedicated to the start of the American democracy.
